Invitation for Persons with Disabilities to Self Identify

Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 requires government contractors, including the University of Hartford, to take affirmative action to employ and advance in employment qualified individuals with disabilities. Submission of this information is voluntary and will be kept confidential. Failure to provide such information will not subject you to disciplinary treatment or discharge.
